Leeds Dads is a voluntary organisation that brings together a diverse community of fathers for social interaction and support. We are here to inspire Dads to take an active parenting role, so that they can have a positive impact in strengthening their family unit. We host regular free activities for Dads such as pram-friendly walks, forest school sessions, soft play, playgroup meetups and we run weekly evening support sessions offering a safe space to check in on our members mental health.

During the first year of the Covid 19 pandemic we delivered Dadstastic Day online, and reinvented our approach to offer the best support we could without being able to meet in person. Our volunteers created:
